The IASE Executive Committee met monthly from September 2023 to June 2024, except for December 2023. The Executive Committee discussed and made decisions regarding conferences local and international committees, approvals of recommended advisory board members for SERJ, ways to improve our membership levels, support for the ISLP, and monitoring the progress on moving to a new website portal.

Dani Ben-Zvi led as President from July 19 to October 7, 2023. After that date, Ayse Bilgin and M. Alejandra Sorto collaborated on the association's leadership for about 5 months. Starting on March 24, 2024, the Executive Committee decided to follow the <a href="IASE Statutes">IASE Statutes</a> on Executive Committee 6.8 which states the following:

6.8 In the event that the Presidency is vacant or that the President is for any other reason unable to fulfill his/her responsibilities, the President-Elect shall serve for the remaining term of the President or until the President shall again be able to serve, as the case may be. If the President-Elect is for any reason unable to fulfill this responsibility, one of the Vice Presidents shall be elected by the Executive Committee in his/her place.

It was decided that the President-Elect, M. Alejandra Sorto, will serve as Acting President until the President, Dani Ben-Zvi, shall again be able to serve. Update: On July 7, 2024, Dani submitted his resignation as IASE President. The Executive Committee will meet on July 31, 2024, to decide on the next steps.

#### 1. IASE Monthly Newsletter

The monthly newsletter is now distributed to the members using a MailChimp account (starting November 2023). This allows for a new look and mobile-friendly reading. The newsletter is sent to 453 recipients from around the world. Messages are accepted in multiple languages for multiple audiences.

<u>IASE 2023 Satellite conference</u> - Fostering Learning of Statistics and Data Science was held as a hybrid satellite conference on 11-13 July 2023 in Toronto, Canada.

There was a total of 143 participants, 43 presentations and 27 poster sessions. Over 35% of participants were students, postdoctoral fellows, or early career faculty.

**ISLP International Day of Statistical Literacy** was held for the first time on a virtual modality on May 21<sup>st</sup>, 2024.

The International Statistical Literacy Project (ISLP) organised its first-ever, free online conference. The day was full of insight and fresh ideas, with topics ranging from improving the statistical literacy of decision-makers, to data science and Big Data, to presentations by previous winners of the ISLP Poster Competition and ISLP Best Cooperative Award. The 8-hour conference inaugurated the first-ever International Day of Statistical Literacy. The conference proceedings and recordings of session presentations will be made available online shortly. The day was organised by a Central Organizing Committee and an Invited Organizing Committee which were chaired by Saleha Naghmi Habibullah from Pakistan, a member of the ISLP Executive.

#### 5. Financial Report

The preliminary financial report for 2023 is attached in **Appendix A**, supplied by the ISI Permanent Office. By the end of 2023 we had a total reserve of €132,780, with a surplus of €1,101 from the previous year. 2023 Satellite Conference income and expenses are presented separately in the statement, the conference made €1,631.

#### 6. Membership

The interim membership report created on 10 June 2024 is attached in **Appendix B** which includes more than 10 years of data. The 3-year rolling average is about 427 members with ICOTS 11 year (2022) contributing the most. Membership is still recovering from the pandemic years but it shows healthy growth in the last two years. The table below shows the number of members on the last day of each year, except in 2024.
